Seating Policy

Lawn chairs are permitted. Unattended items of any kind will not be permitted in the Civic Center park before 3 p.m. For the 2009 summer season, due to local water restrictions, no blankets will be allowed on the lawn before or during the

concerts. (Blankets trap heat which will cause damage to the lawn areas.)

The following are prohibited:

- Tents, umbrellas, grills, portable generators, items that disrupt the concert
- Reserving space by staking and/or cordoning with ropes, tape or any other material
- Hanging or posting anything on trees, other plants or light posts

Alcohol Policy

Picnickers may bring beer or wine with their picnic lunches. All other alcoholic items are prohibited.
